The Oranga Tamariki Action Plan: Implementation Plan

Portfolio **Children**

On 4 July 2022, Cabinet:

- 1 **noted** that, on 4 April 2022, Cabinet endorsed the Oranga Tamariki Action Plan (the Action Plan) which sets out how chief executives and their agencies will work together to achieve the outcomes set in the Child and Youth Wellbeing Strategy for the core populations of interest to Oranga Tamariki, as required by the Children's Act 2014 [CAB-22-MIN-104.01];
- 2 **endorsed** the Oranga Tamariki Action Plan Implementation Plan (the Implementation Plan) attached to the paper under CAB-22-SUB-0255;
- 3 **noted** that the Implementation Plan is an important companion to the Oranga Tamariki Action Plan as it communicates:
 - 3.1 the commitment from children's agencies to collectively find solutions and do whatever it takes to ensure children, young people, families and whānau who need help get help;
 - 3.2 the approach agencies will take to successfully deliver this change;
 - 3.3 what children, young people, and their families and whānau should expect to see when engaging across the system;
 - 3.4 the practical steps that agencies have committed to take over the short and medium term;
- 4 **noted** that, if endorsed, the Oranga Tamariki Action Plan and Implementation Plan will be published before the end of July 2022 on the Oranga Tamariki, and Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet websites;
- 5 **invited** the Minister to report back to Cabinet on progress made in implementing the plans in December 2022.
