Thank you for your email, received on 17 March 2025, to Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki) requesting information on percentage of Vote Oranga Tamariki spending. Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

You have requested:

 I would like to know the percentage of the total Vote Ministry for Children spend on Prevention Wellbeing for the last [last] 6 years? (Prevention of abuse, neglect and family violence)

The information you have requested is publicly available in the Oranga Tamariki Annual Reports.

Please note, reporting of spending is done as whole figures, rather than percentages. In addition, this spend is reported under the category of Prevention and Early Support, except for the 2018/2019 report, where it is described in two separate categories – Early and Intensive Supervision, and Prevention.
