Thank you for your emails, received on 7 and 9 March 2026, to Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki) requesting information on Oranga Tamariki entries into care and funding and spend since 2018 for entries into care, placement/care costs, etc. Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

I have responded to each part of your request below.

OIA 1: OT-OIA-2026-104

Request A: Entries into care by location and ethnicity (national)

A1. For each financial year in the timeframe, please provide the count of entries into care (as defined above), broken down by:

- *location (using the “court location/registry” field or proxy described above), and*
- *ethnicity (using the ethnicity field described above).*

Information pertaining to part A1 of your request is not stored in a way that can be filtered to enable us to provide a response to this question. As such, this part of your request is refused under section 18(f) of the Act, on the grounds that the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.

A2. If held in a reportable form without manual file review, please also provide the same breakdowns with:

- *age bands, and*
- *placement type at entry (using the placement type categories held in your system).*

The information you have requested is provided in **Appendix A**, with the tabs highlighted red and green respectively, and titled “CP Placements Age bands” and “CP Placements by Placements Type”.

This data captures all tamariki in care from unborn (-1) to 18+. Unborn children may appear in the data where concerns have been identified before birth and involvement with Oranga Tamariki has begun for assessment or planning purposes. Young people aged 18+ may also appear where they were previously in care and continue to receive transition support. As with other entries into care information, this has been prepared from operational data and may be subject to change. It should be noted that some tamariki and rangatahi may have more than one entry episode in the period shown.

The Statutory Intervention and Transition departmental output expense within the Investing in Children and Young People Multi-Category Appropriation (MCA) is used to fund care placements and care-related services for children in Oranga Tamariki care.

The Appropriation Vote¹ Statutory Intervention and Transition departmental output expense sets the budgeted level of spending within this category.

The Bednight Rate includes all costs necessary for the Provider to meet the reasonable needs of the child(ren) or young person(s) being cared for, including board, personal items, pocket money, direct Personnel costs, On-costs (if any), and overheads, but excluding Accommodation Rate, Mileage Rate, and any Extraordinary Costs where applicable.

Charges must be calculated in accordance with the applicable Oranga Tamariki rate card and accommodation rate band, unless exceptional rates are approved in advance by the Oranga Tamariki Chief Financial Officer. Where no applicable rate card or accommodation rate band exists, or where exceptional rates are requested, the Provider must provide Oranga Tamariki with sufficient documentation to demonstrate the rationale for the rates requested, including the financial information referred to in Standard Terms and Conditions, Fee for Service.

- accompanying the child or young person on excursions, to school, and/or to appointments and providing guidance and emotional and physical support as required.
- acting as temporary, rostered, or relief Care Staff, or short break Caregiver (as defined in the Shared Care Service Specification).

Hourly Rate means an amount payable to the Provider for each hour that Approved Personnel spend delivering the Services, where the Services involve the provision of Resource Workers or Contingent Workers.
