Thank you for your email of 22 January 2021 to Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki), requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- I am requesting documentation that outlines any OT funding to Pacific focused social services organisations including those associated with Pacific churches and Pacific churches themselves for the years 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021 (if available).
- I would also like to see documentation that outlines any OT funding to organisations that respond to family violence and sexual violence for the above time frame.

On 27 January 2021, we contacted you to enquire whether you were interested in Family Violence and Sexual Violence services that are Pacific-focused, or all Family Violence and Sexual Violence services that we fund. On 3 and 4 February 2021, you clarified you were only interested in Pacific-focused Family Violence and Sexual Violence services, and the following:

- Having looked back over my initial email, I can see that my query was a bit vague. To make it more specific, can I please see a list that outlines any Pacific Social services that Oranga Tamariki fund, and how much funding those services received per annum in the years, 2018, 2019, 2020, and if available 2021.
- An example of a Pacific social services organisation would be 'Vahefonua Tongan Methodist Mission Charitable Trust'.

All information provided for F2020/21 is dated as at 22 January 2021. The funding for this year is subject to contracting and may change. Organisations self-identify as Pacific-focused as part of the Social Services Accreditation process. Although we have tried to be as comprehensive as possible, we cannot guarantee every organisation which has a Pacific focus is included in this information.

Please find in the table below, the total number of providers that self-identify as Pacific-focused and Oranga Tamariki funding to these providers for the financial years 2018 to 2021.
