Thank you for your email of 19 January 2021 to Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki), requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

• The number of young people who are under the care of Oranga Tamariki, under a s14(1)(d) and s14(1)(e) order in 2020.

I understand that you have been corresponding with in order to clarify the timeframe of your request. Please find our response below.

In the financial year 2019/20, which covers the period 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020, 178 Family Group Conference (FGC) referrals were received under section 247(a) of the Oranga Tamariki Act 1989. Section 247(a) is used to refer children and young people who meet the definition outlined in section 14(1)(e) of the Oranga Tamariki Act 1989.

We are unable to provide the number of FGC referrals that were received in relation to children and young people who meet the definition outlined in section 14(1)(d). This information is not centrally recorded in a way that we can report on and would require us to review all FGC plans, outcomes, and recommendations for 2019/20. Therefore, we are refusing this part of the request under section 18(f) of the Act, as the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.
