

Thank you for your email of 15 August 2023 to Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki), requesting information around settlements that have been paid out to staff and non-disclosure agreements. Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

I have addressed each of your questions below.

How many settlements have been paid out to staff for complaints against the department/agency over the last year, the last five years and the last ten years?

How many of those settlements included non-disclosure agreements?

Please see the below table which shows the number of settlements that have been paid out to staff for complaints since 2017.

Oranga Tamariki formally came into existence in November 2017, therefore we have provided data on the settlements that have been paid since that date. We are unable to provide data prior to that date and therefore we are refusing that part of your request under 18(g) of the Act, as we do not hold the information. You may wish to contact the Ministry for Social Development as they could hold information relevant to your request.
